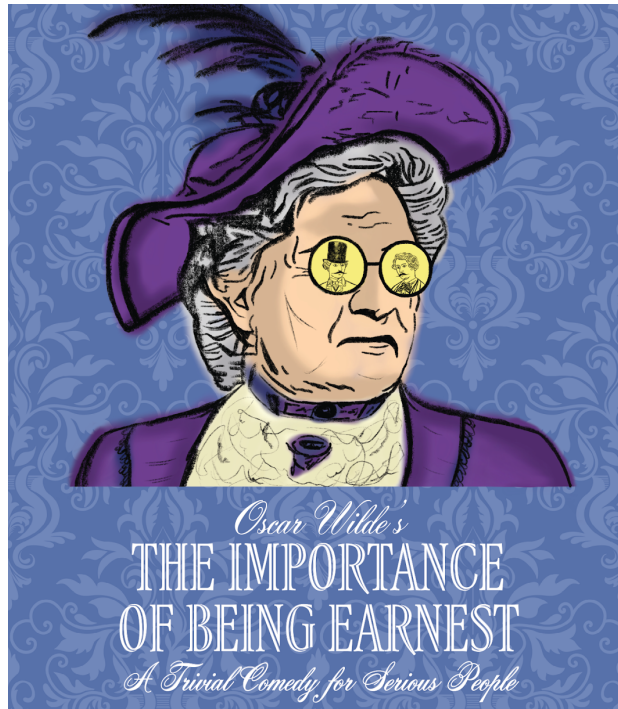

PARENTS AND STUDENTS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING

TRINITAS ARTS CONSERVATORY is an Educational Theatre program. Therefore, it is the goal to give as many students an opportunity to learn and grow through the rehearsal and performance process as possible. Some roles may be double cast or cast with non-performing understudies. Auditioning does not guarantee casting in the production.

Casting is based almost wholly on the strength of the audition with **some** consideration given to a student's involvement and commitment to TAC including years of experience, training, classes, and Thespian affiliation. Students and parents are asked to remember that theatre is a "team sport" with no small parts. **Every part is not right for every student and every student isn't perfect for every show**. Casting in theatre is inherently competitive but students are encouraged to enter into the audition process with a positive, supportive spirit and to **graciously accept whatever role in which they are cast, trusting the judgment of the directing team** and the work of the Holy Spirit. The potential to grow comes with every experience.

THESPIAN PLEDGE:

I promise to perform my part as well as I can, to accept praise and criticism with grace, to cooperate with my fellow Thespians, to work for the good of the troupe, and to share my love of theatre.

Theatre is a group experience demanding the cooperation of the individual for the good of the whole. If an individual's actions or behavior jeopardize the safety or good of the cast through lack of discipline, respect or action, he/she will be dismissed from the cast. This includes:

- **Being ON TIME to rehearsals – On time is 5 minutes before each rehearsal.**
- Conduct – **Positive attitude & focus on work** when on stage and off during rehearsal time, not socializing
- Preparation—**LINES MEMORIZED BY DEADLINE - JANUARY 3, 2023**

Disciplinary action will be comprised of the following:

1. First Offense – WARNING*
2. Second Offense – PARENTS NOTIFIED
3. Third Offense – DISMISSAL

****Tardiness will result in immediate dismissal from rehearsal, while an unexcused absence may result in the removal of scene or the show altogether (as stated in the TAC Contract/Agreement)***

Student conflicts WILL impact casting. PLEASE BE THOROUGH IN YOUR PLANNING.

LIST ALL CONFLICT DATES AND TIMES ON CONFLICT SHEET

Conflicts may result in students being removed from a role, number, scene or the show.

- PARENTS/GUARDIANS:** Due to the time consuming and complex nature of producing a major production, we ask your careful consideration and cooperation in scheduling family trips and weekend events which conflict with our rehearsal schedule. Please discuss your personal calendar with your student and list all conflicts on the contract. **THESE EVENTS MUST BE LISTED ON YOUR STUDENT'S CONFLICT SHEET.** An unscheduled absence or tardy to rehearsal may result in his/her dismissal from a scene or from the cast.
- PARENT INFORMATION MEETING:** After the show has been cast, there will be a **mandatory** meeting for all parents of cast members on **Tuesday, December 13th 6:30 pm.** One adult from each family is required to attend. If a parent is absent from the meeting, a separate meeting appointment must be made with Mr. Betts before **December 16th.** Failure to meet will result in your student unable to attend rehearsal until the meeting has occurred.
- PARTICIPATION FEE (Due December 13th): \$400 Non-Refundable Participation Fee.** This fee includes your costume, all wigs and specialty make-up, a show shirt, a show DVD, link to all show photos including cast & crew group photos, meals for the last 3 tech rehearsals, and the strike party. First time students also receive basic show make-up. This fee does not include lanyards, shoes, socks or undergarments. **A \$20 Audition fee will be applied towards the participation fee (\$400) and the balance is due before or at the parent meeting (\$380).** Please note that per executive policy, all accounts must be current for students to participate in the show and participation fee must be paid in full by the parent meeting to remain in the cast. The participation fees for a show or Comedy Sportz must be paid in full by the date listed above. Payment plans are not available. **All payments for participation must be made through Blackbaud.** If you do not have an account, parents will receive an email from Blackbaud to create an account. This must be done by the parent meeting in order for us to process the payment for the production.
- SALES REQUIREMENT: 15 tickets for each cast member.** To meet this requirement, tickets are purchased online on our ticket website. Donations will count for the requirement by \$ value. Ticket commitments for this production not met by Tuesday, January 30, 2023 will be billed to your account and must be paid immediately. We cannot reverse these Blackbaud charges, so make sure to have your tickets purchased by January 30, no exceptions.
- SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS:** Students must have a 2.0 G.P.A. for the current quarter in order to participate in the show. The contract includes an academic counselor's signature. Students participating in any TAC Production are bound by the policies of their individual schools. In particular, please pay special attention to the Sexual Harassment policy – appropriate behavior must be exhibited at all times, as well as the Attendance Policy - students MUST be in attendance at school for at least 2 block periods or 4 regular class periods in order to attend extracurricular activities – this includes rehearsals and performances.
- ALCOHOL/DRUG POLICIES:** Use of alcohol or drugs is STRICTLY PROHIBITED. Any student suspected of drinking or being under the influence of any substance at rehearsal or performance will be referred to the Dean or Principal of that student's school and parents will be contacted immediately. The student will be sent home.
- REHEARSALS WILL END PROMPTLY.** Please respect the time and schedules of TAC employees and pick up your student on time. It is not safe to ask your student to wait in the parking lot after rehearsal has ended.

I HAVE THOROUGHLY READ AND NOTED THE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR THE TAC PRODUCTION OF *THE IMPORTANCE OF BEING EARNEST* AND THE REHEARSAL CALENDAR ON THE CONFLICT SHEET.
